- 1. Candidates should carefully read the Prospectus before filling up the application form online.

 All rows / columns in the application should be correctly and completely filled in.
- 2. Candidates may submit applications online at www2.tanuvas.ac.in, www.tanuvas.ac.in, on or before 28.09.2020, 6.00 PM. ONLY ONLINE APPLICATION WILL BE ACCEPTED. OTHER FORMATS OF APPLICATION WILL SUMMARILY BE REJECTED.
- 3. Candidates may apply for BVSc & AH and / or BTech (Food Technology / Poultry Technology / Dairy Technology) degree programmes through a single online application, provided they have paid the application / registration fees as detailed below, before submitting the application.

- 4. If, for any reason (for want of more details), the candidate is not able to fill in all the required columns at a stretch, he / she may SAVE the application for future access. Upon saving the application, the candidate can Login by entering their e-mail / mobile number and password (One Time Password OTP) for editing the contents later and submission before the due date.
- 5. After filling in all the relevant columns in the application and upload necessary documents / certificates, the candidates may recheck the details provided by them before submission through **PREVIEW**.
- 6. Candidates should ensure that correct amount of ONLINE APPLICATION FEE paid by using the method viz. a) Credit Card b) Debit Card c) Internet Banking and d) IMPS in the ONLINE PAYMENT GATEWAY.

- 7. After the online submission of application and uploading necessary documents / certificates, the candidate will receive an SMS and email that his / her application(s) is (are) submitted successfully.
- 8. After the receipt of this SMS / email, the candidates may take a print out of the application for their reference. Candidates not receiving the SMS / e-mail even after 48 hours post submission may contact the Admission Committee through email admission@tanuvas.org.in.

- 9. No addition, deletion or alteration of any particulars relating to the application is permitted after the submission of the application.
- 10. The scanned copy of certificates / documents to be uploaded for online application are passport size photograph of the candidate, signature of the candidate and parents / guardians, HSC / CBSE / other equivalent mark sheet, Hall ticket of 12th standard examination, 11th mark sheet (if applicable), Transfer Certificate, Community Certificate, relevant Certificates for Special categories (if required) and Nativity Certificate (if applicable).

11. Sports quota:

- a. The candidates of academic stream who wish to apply for BVSc & AH / BTech (Food Technology / Poultry Technology / Dairy Technology) degree programme under sports quota are requested to read the details and guidelines for sports quota (Appendix II as on Page No. 44).
- b. They are requested to arrange the certificates year-wise (June 2016 to May 2017, June 2017 to May 2018, June 2018 to May 2019 and June 2019 to May 2020 as mentioned in Annexure IV, Page No. 55) and scanned copy of the sports certificates and related documents / forms should be kept ready before filling the application.
- c. The candidates need to fill the relevant details of sports particulars and upload the relevant certificates year-wise.
- d. After filling sports particulars and uploading the certificates, the candidates shall view the summary of the sports particulars and Annexure IV (List of certificates considered for each year with marks). Candidates may edit the particulars for any changes if required.
- e. Mere filling and uploading of the sports certificates **DOES NOT GUARANTEE** for assignment of marks as claimed by the candidate. The Sports marks will be assigned after scrutiny of their application and certificates / documents uploaded.
- f. Candidates can not add / modify any documents / certificates after submission. Hence, candidates are requested to read the guidelines carefully, fill the particulars promptly, upload the certificates / documents correctly, verify the Annexure IV before submission.
- 12. In case of revaluation / re-totalling in respect of qualifying examination, the copy of revaluation / re-totaling mark certificate should be sent to "The Chairman, Admission Committee (UG)", immediately by mentioning the application number already submitted.

- 13. Candidates should ensure that correct particulars of date of birth, community, marks and nativity are furnished by him/her in the application. On scrutiny, if any of these particulars furnished in the application are found incorrect:
 - i. He / she will forfeit the admission to the degree programme itself, no matter at what stage of the course he / she may be at that time.
 - ii. He / she will be debarred from pursuing any degree programme of this University and other Universities of Tamil Nadu for a period of three years.
 - iii. Legal action will be initiated against him / her for furnishing wrong information.
